SENIOR ROTC SCHOLARSHIP PRESENTATION

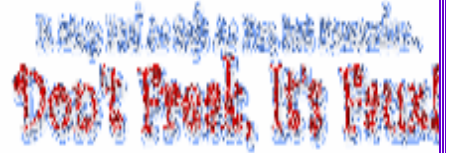
